



CAMBRIDGE COVID-19 VACCINATION SUPER WEEKEND

Extra walk-in clinics in city centre and Arbury

A vaccination 'super weekend' is lined up in Cambridge, with extra walk-in centres set up to enable anyone aged 18 or over to get their first or second Covid-19 jab without an appointment.

Case numbers have spiralled across the county, but particularly in the city, where vaccination rates are lagging behind.

Official data shows Cambridge has the lowest take-up in the East of England, and depending on which population estimate is used, is in the lowest 10 or 20 places in the country.

With Covid-19 restrictions due to end on July 19, there is a major push to drive up vaccination rates.

When attending a walk-in vaccination, you should bring:

- a face mask / covering - this is essential
- Identification and your NHS number, if possible

If going for your second dose, you can take along the card you were given when you had your first, if you still have it, so the batch number can be filled in on it. You may wish to bring a bottle of water to have afterwards.

Second doses are available to anyone over 18 who had their first dose at least eight weeks ago.
