Today they launched the Safe Spaces scheme with Boots UK. All Boots UK stores will facilitate their consultation rooms as Safe Spaces, enabling victims of domestic abuse to access specialist domestic abuse support services.

How it works

- All Boots UK stores will facilitate their consultation room as a Safe Space.
- A poster will indicate to Boots customers that they can ask at the healthcare counter to use the Safe Space.
- The Safe Space will have information on national helplines and how to download the Bright Sky app, which provides information on local, specialist domestic abuse services and other resources.
