



VACCINE WALK-IN CENTRES OPEN ACROSS CAMBRIDGESHIRE

Walk-in centres are offering anyone aged 40+ the chance to get their second jab without an appointment

Those in need of their second coronavirus vaccine are now able to get one without an appointment in Cambridgeshire.

The walk-in clinics have been set up to allow anyone in need of their second AstraZeneca vaccine to be able to get one, whenever they are available and without an appointment.

The clinics are open to anyone aged 40 and over as well as those who are clinically vulnerable. There are seven vaccination centres open across Cambridgeshire to make it easy for anyone in need to get the jab.

Walk-in AstraZeneca clinics are available at the following vaccination centres daily from 9.00 am to 3.00 pm from Thursday, 24 June to Sunday, 4 July:

From Monday, 28 June 2021 to Sunday, 4 July, an evening walk-in clinics at The Grafton Centre will also be available between 5.30 pm to 7.30 pm
